

HKP33 - Pat's Lacey Scarf



Skill Level: Beginner

Sizes: 1 size

Finished Measurements: 52" long X 6" wide

Yarns: Ker from Filtes King 33% Wool 30% Nylon 28% Acrylic 9% Alpaca - 74 yard (68 m) / 1.75 oz (50 g) ball or yarn similar in size

Amount: 2 - 1.76 oz (50 g) skeins

Needles: 13 US (9 mm) straight

Stitch Gauge: 11 stitches per 4" (10 cm)

Techniques Used: [CO HKT2](#), [K HKT3](#), [P HKT8](#), [K2tog HKT14](#), [ssk HKT16](#), [YO HKT18](#), [BO HKT4](#)

Extras: none

Tired of making the garter stitch scarf? This simple lace scarf is quick to make, but is more interesting to make than the basic garter stitch scarf. The techniques used are easy to knit, so a beginner can still make it.

Instructions

CO 15 st.

Stitch 1 - 3X3 Rib Lace

R1: K3, P3, K3, P3, K3.

R2: K4, YO, K2tog, K4, YO, K2tog, K3.

R3: K3, P3, K3, P3, K3.

R4: K3, ssk, YO, K4, ssk, YO, K4.

Rep R1 - R4 three more times.

Stitch 2 - Garter Lace

R5: K all.

R6: K all.

R7: * K2tog, YO, K1 * Rep from * to end.
Rep R5 - R7 five more times.
R8: K all.
R9: K all.

Rep Stitches 1 & 2 until desired length of scarf is created. BO.
Sample was made in 5 total Rep of Stitches 1 & 2 plus 1 additional Rep of Stitch 1. This makes the scarf ends in Stitch 1.

Finishing

Weave in yarn ends.
